How to Join GUMBA

Each GUMBA member is asked to make a commitment of riding patrol, assisting on trail work projects, or helping out with advocacy events.

Gumba bike patrols assist visitors by providing directions, inner tubes, first aid and friendly advice to those in need. Patrols are run Saturday, Sunday and holidays from 10 am to 4 pm. We usually run 2 patrols at both Minnewaska the Mohonk Preserve, so we need about 8 patrollers per day, or 16 people to cover a weekend. If you don't have a regular partner to patrol with, we will try to pair you up with someone of your riding level and experience. Patrol riders are admitted free of charge, on the days they ride patrol, to the Mohonk Preserve and Minnewaska State Park. Patrollers are asked to ride a patrol a month from May to October, and to ride one holiday.

Becoming a GUMBA bike patroller requires some training, which GUMBA provides.
